<b>Midriffs</b>	<b>With Holes or Tears</b>	<b>Pajama/House Shoes</b>
<b>Strapless/Backless/Halter</b>	<b>Running Shorts that are more than 5 inches from the top of the knee (Nike, Under Armor, etc.)</b>	<b>Shoes with skinny heels/wedges/platforms</b>
<b>Tube Tops</b>	<b>Shorts/Skirts/Skorts that are more than 5 inches from the top of the knee</b>	<b>Sport Cleats</b>
<b>See through shirts (Sheer)</b>	<b>Skirts/Dresses without playground shorts or leggings underneath</b>	<b>Skate Shoes</b>
<b>Tight or form fitting shirts</b>	<b>Leggings/Jeggings without a top/dress that covers the middle of the thigh.</b>	<b>Slides (Nike slides, etc.)</b>
<b>T-Shirts with inappropriate advertisement and logos (guns, alcohol, profanity, gang signs, etc.)</b>	<b>Clothing where the undergarments can be seen</b>	
<b>Pajama Tops</b>	<b>Pajama Bottoms (long or short)</b>	
<b>Any oversized shirt</b>
